The B.C. Winter Games Host society is seeking Volunteer therapists for the 2018 B.C. winter games, being held in Kamloops B.C. from Feb 22-26. The B.C. winter games will play host to 1500-2300 participants and cover 18 different sports at 11 different venues. Therapists will be needed for medical coverage on site at events, and at the polyclinic. The Games are looking to recruit Physiotherapists, Athletic Therapists and Massage therapists.

Duties of therapists include:

- Provide athlete assessments and treatment as indicated within the Medical Clinic or at the venues.
- Keep record of treatments
- Assist in maintaining all equipment and supplies
- Recommend treatment programs that can be followed the injured person upon returning home and/or liaise with home practitioners
- At the venues, provide primary first aid on the playing surfaces. May also provide preventative taping/massage.
- At the venues, assist with and in some cases supervise the evacuation of an injured person to the polyclinic.
- To provide care at venues sport first responder first aid is necessary
